Try the current solo exhibition by Nina Fowler. *That's Right Mister*, and *How's Your Fairy Tale Coming Along* is the first large-scale installation of sculpture and drawings that she has exhibited in the UK. Steeped in the saturated glitz of golden-era Hollywood, it "explores the contrast of the surface's shimmer and an anxiety over the emptiness it might conceal". Till Nov 9.
